SECURE YOUR VALUABLES

History has shown that during depressed economic times certain types of crimes of opportunity tend to increase. While we, here in St. Pete Beach enjoy a relatively safe and low crime community we still need to stay alert and take some simple crime prevention precautions.

- **Do not leave the keys in the vehicle.**
Take them with you! Have a spare set stored safely off-site. And **PLEASE LOCK YOUR VEHICLE.**
- **Be aware of Strangers in your neighborhood!**
This is the most important prevention of all – many pairs of eyes and ears looking out for each other to prevent theft.
- **REPORT any suspicious activity or noise immediately**
Report information to the Police as it is happening; this could not only prevent the theft but apprehend the criminals and stop the cycle.
