St. Pete Beach Police and the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office have just concluded a joint Narcotics Investigation, dubbed "*Operation Crackdown*". This enforcement operation targeted street-level drug dealers living and operating on St. Pete Beach, resulting in Probable Cause (PC) to arrest 23 suspects for a variety of Narcotics charges, developed through the Joint Task Force investigation. As of today, 13 of the 23 people have been apprehended.

"*Operation Crackdown*" is the latest sting in a continuing enforcement wave aimed at eradicating drug sales on St. Pete Beach. This joint operation is a culmination of efforts by Officers and Detectives of the St. Pete Beach Police Department, together with Detectives from the Pinellas County Sheriff's Narcotics Division. Numerous concerned citizens of St. Pete Beach also assisted with various aspects of, and at various stages of the investigation.
